## Residential Stepchild Verification Form (Form RS-1)

The Massachusetts Public Employees Fund (the "Fund") provides coverage for dependent children through the last day of the month during which the child turns 19, or through the last day of the month in which they turn 26 if enrolled as a full-time student. The Fund defines the term "child" (or "children") to "include any natural child, residential stepchild, legally adopted child or child for whom the Fund member has obtained legal custody and with whom the Fund member maintains a parent/child relationship and for whom the Fund member provides regular financial support."

The Fund will provide coverage to a Fund member's residential stepchild if all of the following criteria are met:

- 1) The Fund member is legally married to the parent of the stepchild; and
- 2) The stepchild resides in the Fund member's household (but may be temporarily away from home while attending school); and
- 3) The stepchild is unmarried; and
- 4) The Fund member is entitled to claim the child as a dependent for federal income tax purposes because the child lives in the member's home (as supported by either the Fund member's most recent federal tax return or a valid court order).
